<u>MATH</u>

By June, 2022, Elementary/Middle School Math for All Students will Increase 3 %, from BOY Assessment to EOY Assessment projected proficiency from 1-2 and 2-3, as measured by NYC MAP Assessment.

<u>ELA</u>

By June, 2022, Elementary/Middle School ELA for All Students will Increase BOY Assessment, from 5% projected proficiency to EOY Assessment, as measured by NYC MAP Assessment.

<u>Social Justice</u> – Access and opportunity identified - Access to interventions - Books and time eyes on text

By June 2022 independent reading will be prioritized with dedicated time both during school and at home in order to promote reading level growth. The school will increase time students spend engaged in reading texts that are both high interest and on their functional level, and provide updated classroom libraries to ensure equitable access to texts.

<u>Culture/Belief</u> – Belief and perceptions identified - High standards/Remediation Mindset

By June 2022, in order to ensure students are held to the same level of *high standards* throughout the school, teachers will engage in guided professional learning and self-paced professional reflection of *Cultivating Genius*. This work will establish a shared school-wide understanding and critical lens on the way in which we plan for and execute culturally responsive pedagogy so we can better serve the academic needs and highlight the academic assets of our student body.

<u>ELL</u>

By June, 2022, English Language Proficiency for English Language Learners will Increase at least .35 , from .15 (Level 1) to Level 2, as measured by ELP success ratio.

CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM

By June, 2022, Chronic Absenteeism for All Students will Decrease 20 percentage points, from 35% to 15%, as measured by ATS Attendance Report (RRSA).

QUALITY IEPS

By May, 2022, to strengthen the quality and implementation of IEPs for All Students with Disabilities (SWD), we will improve writing quality IEP goals that relate to Next Generation Learning Standards by Increase 40, from 40% to 80, as measured by IEP reviews.

SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT

By June, 2022, practices related to Personal Attention & Support will improve 3 percentage points, from 87% to 90%, as measured by positive NYC School Survey responses, resulting in improved Collaborative & Trusting Relationships.

- Data Analysis Dependent Variables Reading Level and Math Level
- Independent variables ELL status, IEP status, gender, STH, Etc.
- Same percent at or above grade level in both math and ELA 22% 8% are below or well below.
- Gender no correlation
- Economically disadvantaged and STH have a higher chance of being below or well below.
- Economic situation and attendance have a strong correlation. Students considered economically advantaged have a much higher chance of becoming chronically absent.
- White students have a higher attendance rate.
- Attendance has a correlation with performance. Statistically significant on Math.
 - Math is sequential learning so being absent has a greater impact on performance.
 - No student who has less than 80% attendance is on or above grade level.
- Reading levels improve with age.
 - More focus on reading intervention, not math intervention.
- Let's have an after school or weekend academy for students who are absent? Focus on skills identified.
- Negative correlation with ELL statu and reading level.
- IEP status has a statistically significant effect on math- need to break down more on IEPnot all IEPs are considered equal.
 - More Math intervention for IEP students

- Black children have the lowest performance. Followed by hispanic followed by white.
